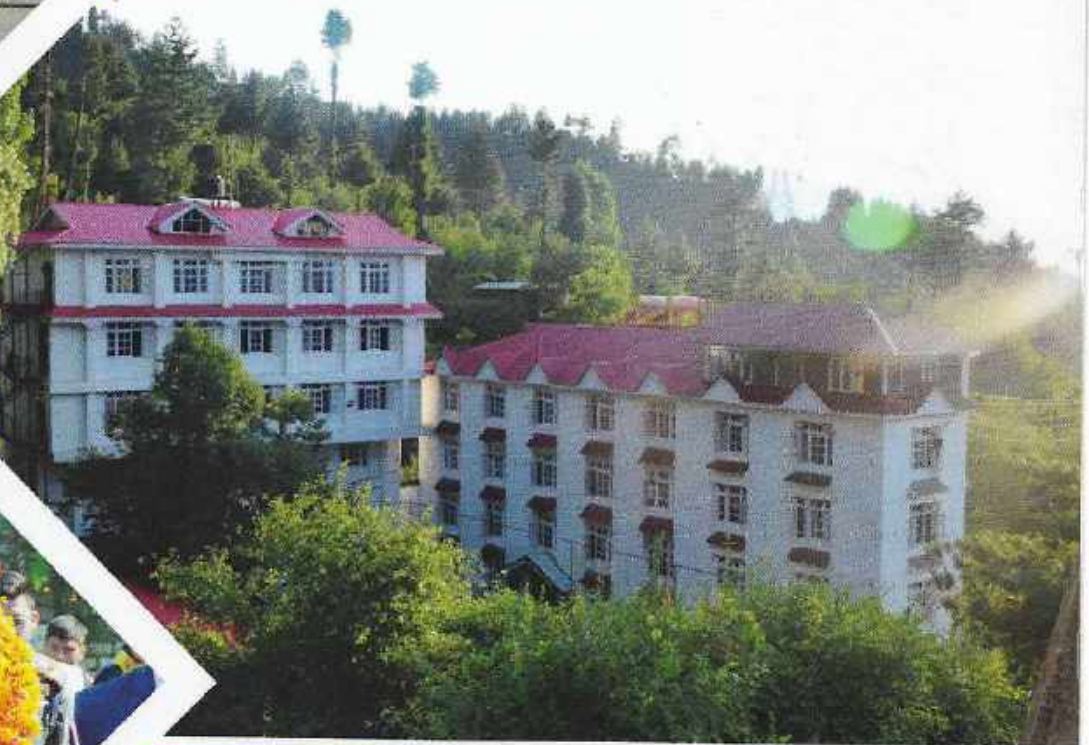

A few kilometres from Shimla, is a beautiful place, where the famous BHIMA KALI TEMPLE is situated. Sports authority of India's High Altitude training center is also located here. In front, you can see the mountain range and behind the beautiful forest range lies the Shrikhand peak. The magnificent palace which belongs to Raja Virbhadra Singh is also situated here.

Introduction



Mr. and Mrs. Bisht are residents of Rangori, which is a peaceful village few kilometres from Sarahan surrounded by apple orchards. Mrs. Bisht hails from Kinnaur district, which is on the high up terrain of the Mighty Himalayas.

This visionary couple had a shared dream of serving the rural people who could not afford to send their children to cities for their education. An apt way to do this was to start a school for all sections of people living in these remote mountain regions. So, they chose a hut at the edge of Sarahan where Mrs. Kunzam Bisht started teaching three children single handedly on March, 1994. Now the school has been shifted to its present location, just below the Nalati Stadium, not very far away from the main bazaar. The school now has more than 300 students about 160 of them staying in the hostel.



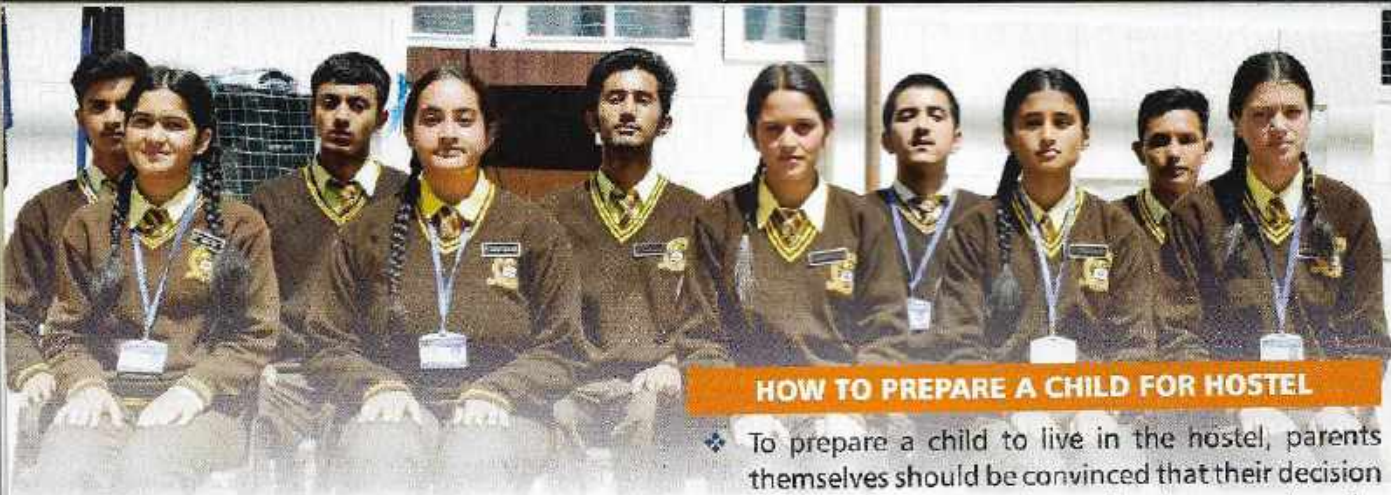
SCHOOL INSIDE

HOW TO PREPARE A CHILD FOR HOSTEL

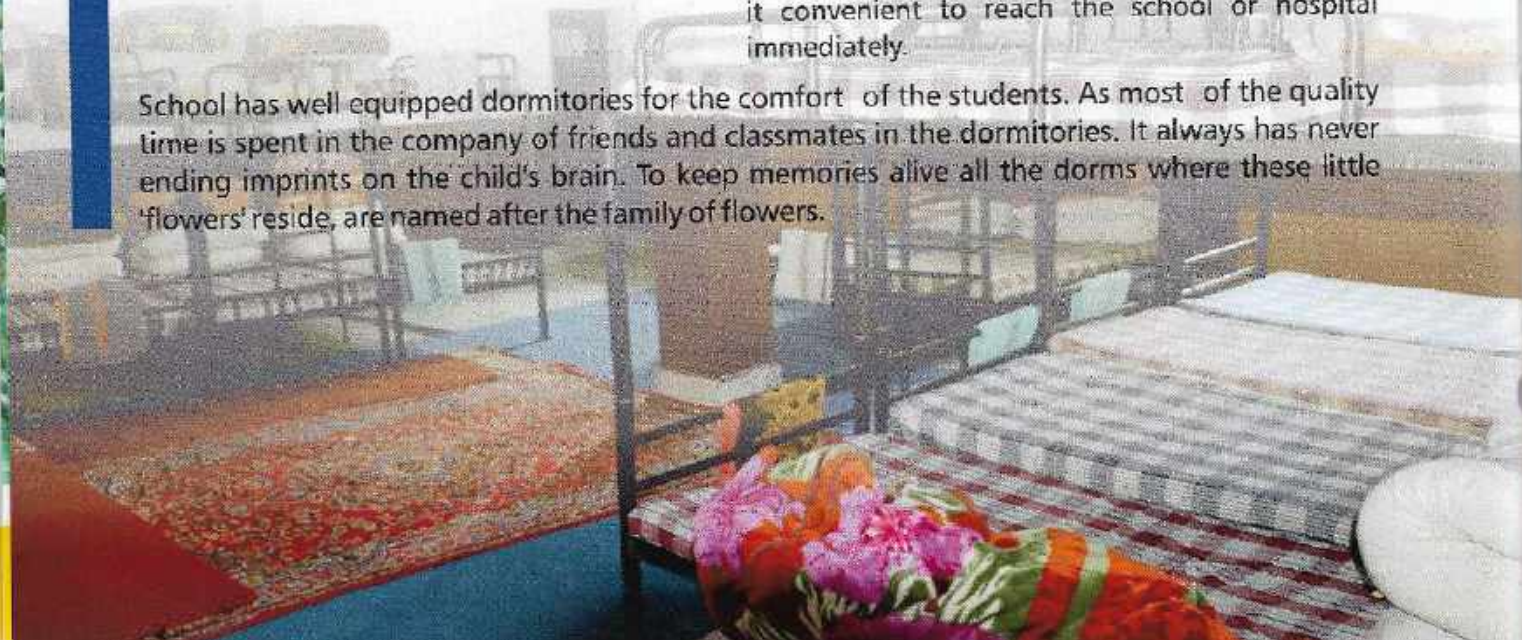
- ❖ To prepare a child to live in the hostel, parents themselves should be convinced that their decision is right. If they are feeling guilty about sending the child away, all their arguments to persuade their offspring will sound hollow to the child.
- ❖ The child should be consulted before a decision is made to send them to the hostel. Give the child sufficient time to understand why they are going to a hostel.
- ❖ The child should be made to realize that the move is for their and not the parent's benefit.
- ❖ The move to send the child to a hostel must not be interpreted by them as punishment, otherwise they will begin to hate and dread the hostel even before joining it.
- ❖ Give examples to the child about positive learning experience, all that a child can gain from the hostel environment. Tell them that you want them to learn more besides studies.
- ❖ Any family friend or a relative to whom the child is close to can also be roped in to talk to the child and dispel their fears. They must be made to realize that the lonely moments will pass away and that they will come back to his parents, who love them dearly.
- ❖ If the child has any problem don't hesitate to bring to the notice of the school authorities.
- ❖ Parents should not panic on hearing from the school, regarding the illness of their child but make it convenient to reach the school or hospital immediately.

HOSTEL

The school also provides boarding facility for 200 students. The dormitories are well furnished with modern sanitary fittings and 24 hour running hot and cold water facility. The warden, matrons along with the teaching staff reside in the hostel building to keep an overall eye.

The students are provided well balanced diet four times a day. The warden and teachers take their meals with the students in the mess. The hostel also provides a common room where the boarders can enjoy in their leisure time.

School has well equipped dormitories for the comfort of the students. As most of the quality time is spent in the company of friends and classmates in the dormitories. It always has never ending imprints on the child's brain. To keep memories alive all the dorms where these little 'flowers' reside, are named after the family of flowers.

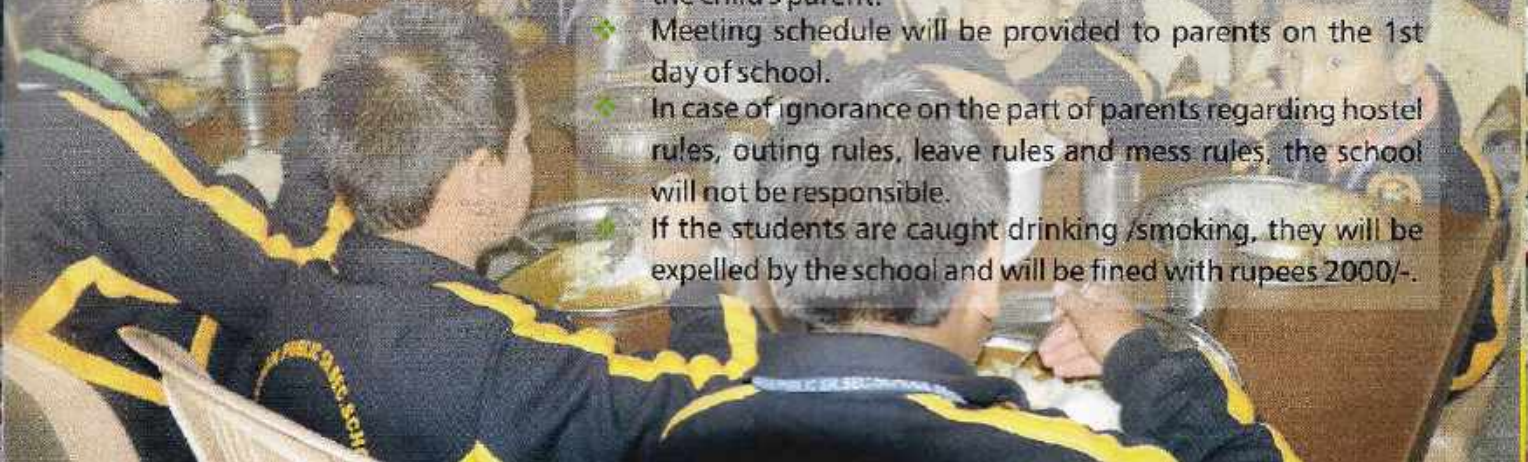

Mess/Food

School has a mess where 200 students can have food in one batch in most hygienic and healthy conditions. Teachers and all other staff also accompany students during every meal to keep the overall eye on nutrition and quality. School had deputed wardens, and mess in-charge as accountable persons. Proper nutrition, tasty food in adequate quantity is our top priority. Under the consultant supervision of the mess in-charge a healthy menu is decided in consultation with the staff and children.

HOSTEL RULES

- ❖ The parents are allowed to meet their wards only on second Saturday and last Sunday of every month and followed by night outs.
- ❖ Duration of visit should not strictly exceed 3 hours.
- ❖ Visiting hours begin strictly after 10 A.M to 5 P.M on Sundays.
- ❖ Parents and guardians are expected to meet their wards by prior permissions of their wardens and not directly in the dormitories.
- ❖ Students are not allowed to keep cash with them. Students are given pocket money every fortnight or when required. Borrowing or lending money and other personal belongings from each others is strictly prohibited.
- ❖ Students must not be given Walkman, I-Pods, Transistors, Mobiles, Electric Shaves, Cameras or other expensive articles to be brought to the hostel. In case of misplacement the school bears no responsibility.
- ❖ For ordinary ailments parents are not informed. If the student is admitted to the hospital a communication is sent to the parent.
- ❖ Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited.
- ❖ In case of damage to the School property and the loss of library books, the recovery will be made from the parent of the student concerned.
- ❖ Leave Holidays will be permitted on valid reasons with a weeks' notice.
- ❖ On completion of vacation, students are expected to reach school on time as per schedule. Fine of Rs. 100/- per day will be levied.
- ❖ Hostel roll number once allotted shall remain for all sessions.
- ❖ One blanket, one quilt, one pillow, two bed sheets, 2 pillow covers, two towels shall be provided by the school for which students are charged once in three years.
- ❖ School uniform, books and stationary shall be available at "needs & more" near school campus.
- ❖ Any damage to school property shall be directly borne by the child's parent.
- ❖ Meeting schedule will be provided to parents on the 1st day of school.
- ❖ In case of ignorance on the part of parents regarding hostel rules, outing rules, leave rules and mess rules, the school will not be responsible.
- ❖ If the students are caught drinking /smoking, they will be expelled by the school and will be fined with rupees 2000/-.

KINDER GARTEN

ACADEMIC SESSION

Since the school is situated at a high altitude and in snow zone, it is closed in winters. The Academic session begins on 15th of February and ends on the 31st of December.

SYLLABUS

Sarahan Public School is an English medium school, although based on H.P. BOARD. Special emphasis is given to improve the spoken English skills of the students. School provides latest computer labs and trained staff to expose and introduce the students to the latest Technological developments and education.

- In its pursuit of excellence and for complete development of the pupils personality, the school society seeks the service of professionals to promote specialized knowledge, moral integrity and dedication of high professional competence.
- The medium of instructions is English. Hindi is also taught as compulsory subject.
- Main subjects taught are : Eng., Math, Hindi, Sci, S.St., IT, GK, and Moral Edu.



EXAMINATION

Complete syllabus is divided into 4 equal parts i.e. FA1, FA2, FA3, FA4 for Classes 1st to 8th followed by summative assessment tests (SA1 & SA2). All the tests and evaluation consists of regular grades secured in various assignments & projects related to subjects. After every assessment report card is sent to parents but the final progress report will be issued after the completion of SA-2 usually in the month of December. For Classes 9th, 11th Annual Examinations will be Conducted. For Classes 10th & 12th there will be two Terms i.e. Term 1 and Term 2.

AFFILIATION

School is affiliated to office of Deputy Director, Elementary Education, Shimla -171004 under affiliation No. HPB-38-2021-29681 from H.P. Board of School Education, Dharamshala (Kangra).

MEDICAL ROOM

The school houses a well equipped medical room. Skilled and experienced professionals are in 24 hr attendance to ensure that all emergencies are handled with utmost care and attention. Regular medical checkup and record is maintained to ensure a healthy environment.

24x7 conveyance facilities are available to deal emergency. In case of emergencies, parents/guardians are informed immediately to handle the situation in the best possible manner.

REGISTRATION AND ADMISSIONS

New admissions are strictly on the basis of an entrance test to be held i.e. From 15th February to 31st March. Number of seats are declared as per the vacancies decided by the Administration. Parents are expected to bring along the progress report of the child from the previous school attended, 4 passport size photos. School leaving certificates in originals are required during the admission formalities. Parents can send enquiries through our website too.

- ❖ Admission is open to all boys and girls irrespective of caste, creed or social status who are mentally and physical by fit having attained the age of 4 years.
- ❖ Application forms for registration / admission to all classes are available at school office.
- ❖ New Admissions are strictly on the basis of entrance test.
- ❖ Number of seats are declared as per the vacancies decided by the administration, which may vary from year to year .
- ❖ Students migrating from other schools must submit Transfer Certificate / School leaving Certificate and progress report from the previous school. In case of fresh admission, birth certificate from local authority is valid.
- ❖ Registration does not guarantee admission.
- ❖ The Principal reserves the right of granting or refusing admission to anyone who seeks admission to the school.
- ❖ Parents can send enquiries through our website too.

SCHOOL SESSION / TERMS

The School observes the academic session from February to December

- 1st term - March to June
- 2nd term - July to December

The School observes Monsoon break, Diwali break and Winter break during the session about which parents will be informed from time to time.



ADMISSION TO +1

Admission to Science (Medical and Non-medical) must have 55% marks in matriculation.

For Commerce it is 50% marks in matriculation.

For Arts it is 50% marks in matriculation.

A student seeking admission to + 1 must have passed Matriculation from any Board provided that he/she has the required documents.

ADMISSION TO +2

A candidate who fails in +2 may also seek admission.

A student who fails twice in +1 and +2 will not be entertained.



NOTES :

- ❖ Admission to + 1 and + 2 will be done within 10 days after the declaration of the result without fine.
- ❖ If the declaration of the result is late, admission will be done provisionally.
- ❖ Full fees will be charged at the time of provisional admission.
- ❖ Fee once paid is not refundable.

eXtra curricular activities



With the arrival of Edu comp. Smart class, students have now audio visual classes which have created the atmosphere of learning more interesting and more participatory. Teachers have been helped greatly in their lesson planning and teaching methods. It is the policy of the school that all the students are trained to become good speakers, leaders. With these in view they are given the chance to speak, during assembly and declamation contest. Quiz competition, handwriting, Drawing Competition are organised every year.
