
Feedback Analysis Report

The feedback of students, faculty, employer and alumni is significant in the improvement of teaching and learning process of an institution. During the academic session of 2021-22, the college also obtained feedback from all the main stakeholders viz., the students and faculty, of the college. In this regard, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college designed the questionnaire separately for students and faculty. Here, the term student is meant for the student who has completed at least one academic session in the college. The questionnaire mainly covered all the issues relating to the curriculum. For the present survey, total 131 students, 9faculty members, were selected by using the random sampling. The results obtained from the survey are analyzed as follows:

Student Feedback Analysis (2021-22)

Students are one of the most significant stakeholders for any educational institution. Their feedback is extremely valuable and can be utilized to review and enhance the teaching-learning techniques of the institution. The results obtained from the survey of the students are analyzed as follows:

Taking into account the students' feedback responses, a majority of the respondents (93.71 percent) accept that the curriculum in which 44.45 strongly agree and 49.26 agree with the curriculum. 50 percent strongly agreed and 42 percent are agreed with course content and organization. 36 percent strongly agreed and 57 percent agreed that there is a good learning environment provided and best teaching methods are adopted by college. 55.42 percent of the respondents agree that the best learning resources available with the college. 82 percent of respondents are satisfied with the quality of delivery of curriculum. 92 percent of respondents are satisfied with assessment of curriculum. Majority of students accept that the overall academic environment is either excellent, very good or good in the college.



Teacher Feedback Analysis

Teachers have been one of the most substantial stakeholders for any educational institution. Their feedback is also significant for improving the teaching-learning techniques of the institution. The results obtained from the survey of the teachers are analyzed as follows:

On the basis of the survey, a majority of them (88.45 percent) satisfied with the curriculum in which 28.84 percent strongly agreed and 60.57 percent agreed with the curriculum. 87.5 percent teachers accept that curriculum is relevant and applicable to real life situations.100 percent teachers accept that courses are relevant to the programme. 87.5 percent teachers accept that Curriculum facilitates adoption of new techniques/strategies of teaching and creates social awareness among the students. All the respondents opine that curriculum has given them opportunities to grow and learn. All the teachers are found satisfied with the methods of teaching. 88 percent of them consider that curriculum inculcates learning values like skill, concepts, Knowledge, analytical abilities, or broadening perspectives. 75 percent of the respondents is satisfied with the timely updating of the curriculum. All the teachers accept that the overall academic environment is excellent, very good or good in the college.
