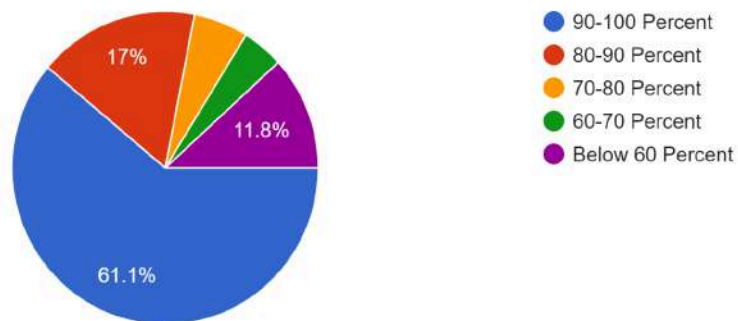


Student Satisfaction Survey 2021-22

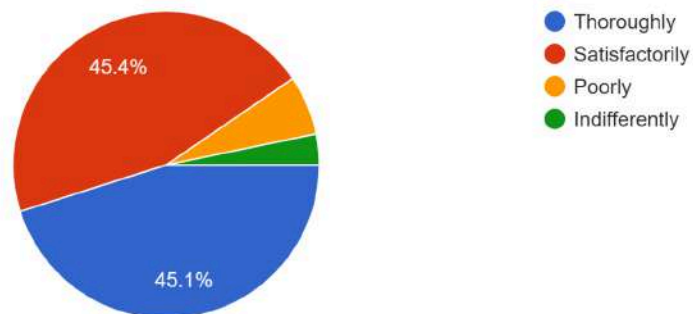
Q 1 How much syllabus covered in the class?

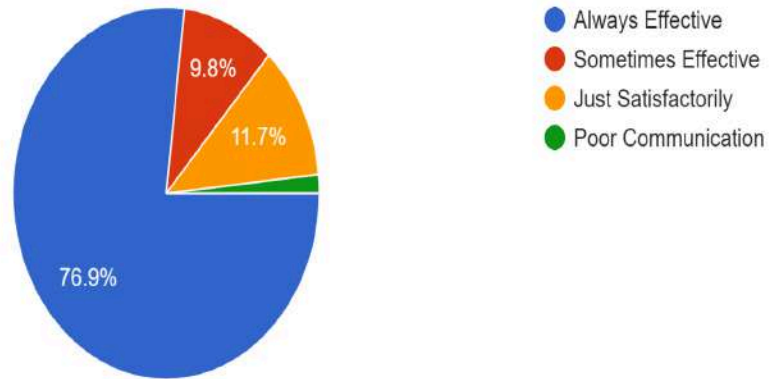
Q 2 How well the teachers prepare for the classes?

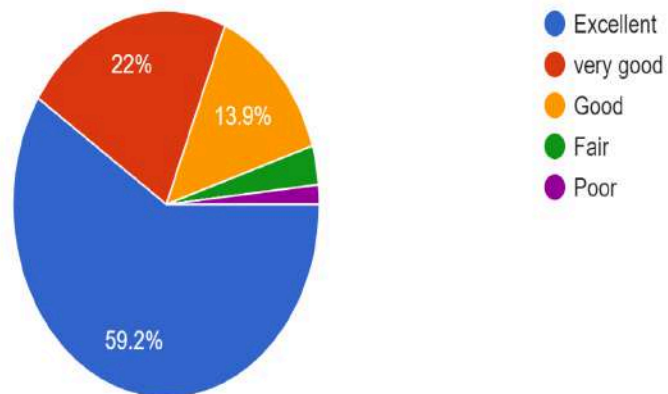
Q 3 How well the teachers able to communicate?

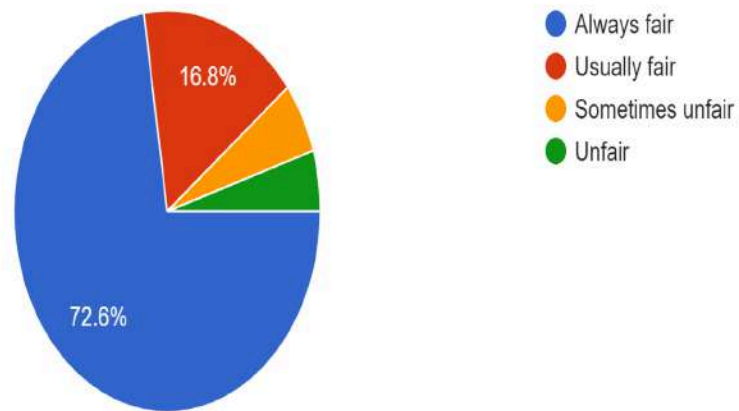
Q 4 The teachers approach to teaching can be best described as

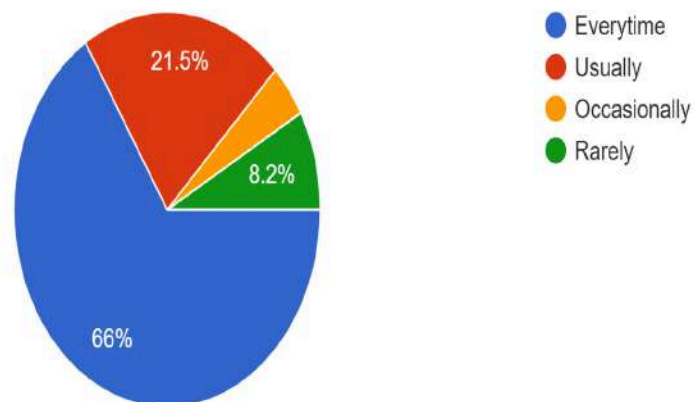
Q 5 Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

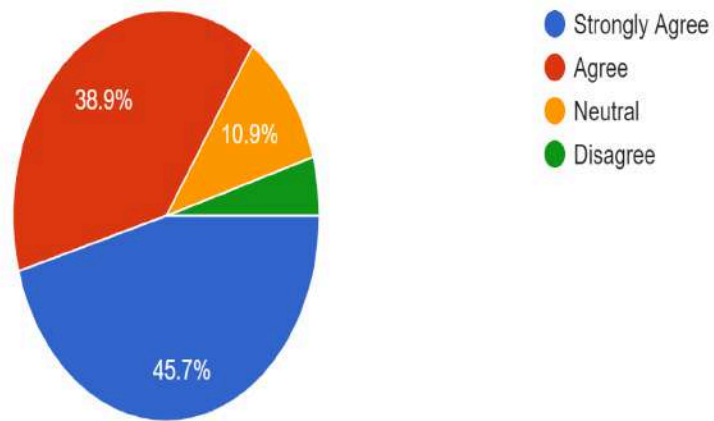
Q 6 Was your performance discussed with you ?

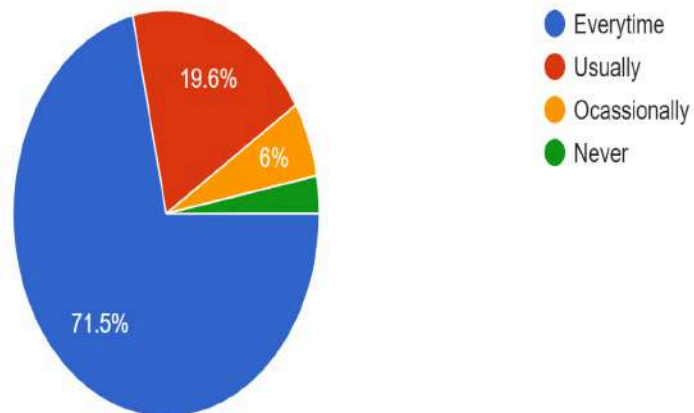
Q 7 The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow

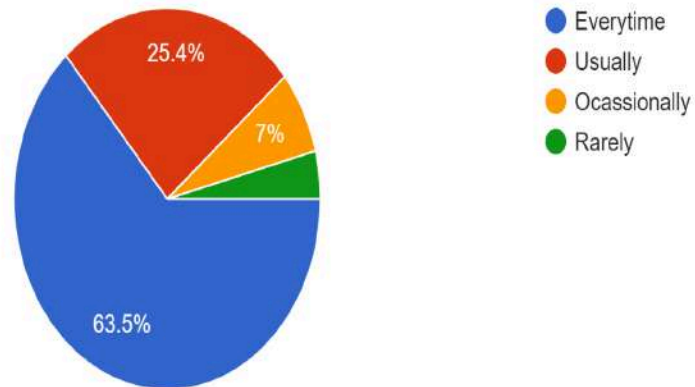
Q 8 Teachers inform you about course outcomes and programme outcomes

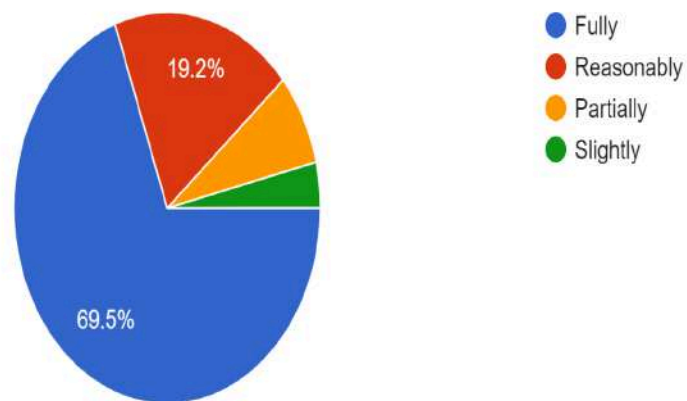
Q9 Your mentor does a necessary follow up with an assigned task to you

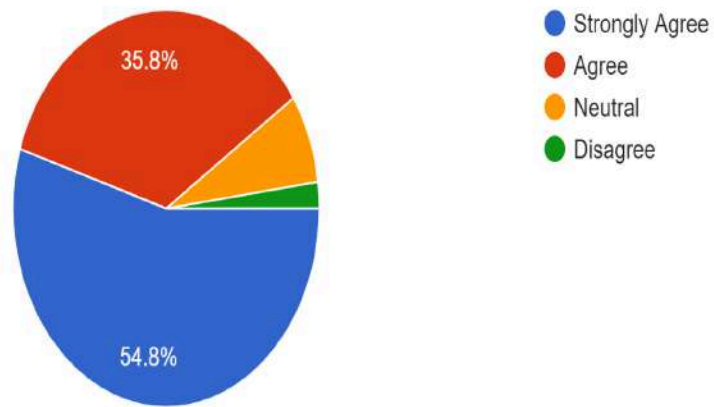
Q10 The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.

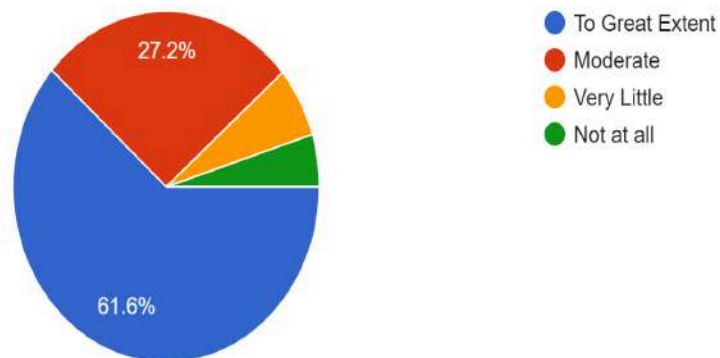
Q 11 Teachers encourage you to participate in extra curricular activities

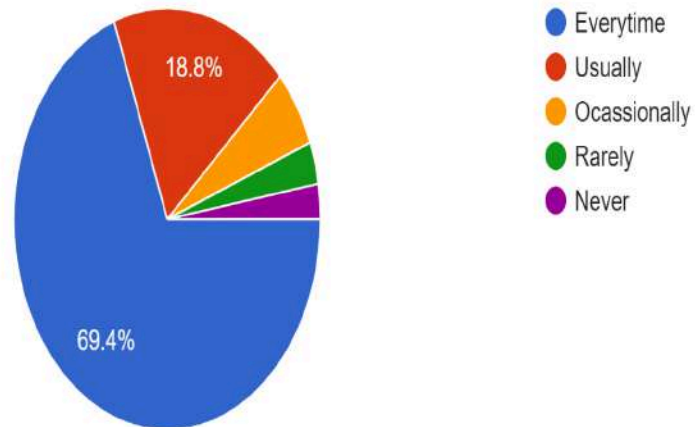
Q 12 efforts are made by the institution / teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work

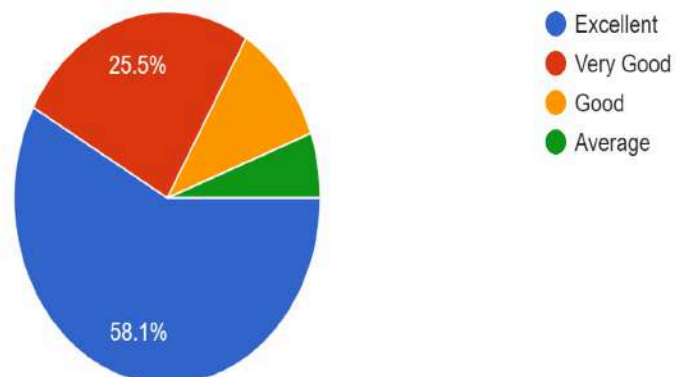
Q 13 The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications
